Dear Parents/Guardians:

Oak View School is proud to present its Annual Summer Reading Program for students entering Grades 1 through 6. Reading is the single best activity to promote thinking and academic success. Additionally, it adds fun to your summer life and because of its importance this program will involve all elementary students throughout Bloomfield. The goal of the program at Oak View School is to enrich the lives of our students by encouraging them to read, read, read during the summer months!

The Summer Reading Program, begins June 27th and concludes August 1, 2017. Students in Grades 1 - 6 will be using a digital reading program called Storia where they will read and track their reading goals. Storia is web-based and compatible with many electronic devices. Students have been given a unique code and password for their accounts. They were given this information from their Teachers. We are asking each child to complete at least 5 books and reading challenges within their reading levels. More than 5 is always encouraged. In addition to digital reading, students are encouraged to read print materials at their appropriate reading levels as well. There are several options listed on our website. Students can receive credit up to August 31st for such reading by submitting a reading log of books they have read. Teachers will recognize their students in September for reaching their reading goals. The top 10% Oak View Summer Readers will be recognized Read Across America Day.

We encourage you to become involved in summer reading with your child. It is only with your encouragement and example that your child will embrace reading as a lifelong pastime.
