We believe that building and enhancing a child's self-esteem empowers our children to reach their highest potential. We hope to build the foundations that will sustain and promote lifelong learning.

Our teaching staff at Oak View prides themselves on differentiating instruction so that students' personal interests, learning styles and needs are met. Using data analysis to drive instruction, setting clear objectives and allowing students to see "real world" applications, help to motivate our students to become life-long learners. At Oak View, our curriculum is aligned very closely with the Common Core Content Standards, teaching Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Health. In addition we provide technology instruction, media classes, vocal and instrumental music, fine arts, physical education, world language, enrichment and guidance classes. Additional services such as speech therapy, occupational therapy and physical therapy are available for students requiring these services. Students at Oak View also benefit from the services of a full time nurse and an experienced child study team.

Oak View School has a very dedicated and hard-working Home and School Association. Parents fundraise to support the curriculum and special school programs such as educational classroom materials, technology, field trips, assemblies and class celebrations. Their total efforts are endless in providing cultural and fun-filled annual events for the whole family. The Home and School meets the first Wednesday of every month at 7:00 in the Library and all are welcome to attend.
